IMPORTANT NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Canadian Pest Control Ltd. will be providing a **PAVEMENT ANT CONTROL SERVICE** in your residence on

_____, at _____ **a.m/p.m.**

You do not need to vacate your unit as we are applying ant baits inside.

If you are in a ground floor unit please keep your windows and doors closed as we will be doing a spray application outside. We also request that you stay away from the exterior perimeter of the building until the treatment is dry (2 hours).

TO ENSURE SUCCESS PLEASE COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING PREPARATIONS

- **Remove *everything*** from next to the outside of the house. No firewood, no lumber, no toys or barbecues within three feet of the building please.
- **Cut back all vegetation and tree branches.** Vegetation should be 18 inches off the walls, and tree branches should be three feet away. Also ensure the concrete foundation is exposed; no soil up against the siding.
- **Reduce clutter inside!** Ants hide in cluttered areas, especially near heat and moisture.
- **Thoroughly vacuum** all floor level cracks and crevices to remove food.
- **Clean all areas of the kitchen**, especially under the fridge and stove, and anywhere crumbs accumulate.
- **Fix dripping taps** or leaking pipes, roof leaks, and any gaps around windows, doors, or siding that may allow moisture inside.
- **Replace all rotting wood in the house, deck, or landscaping.**
- **Ensure attics and crawlspaces are properly ventilated.**

You may experience activity for up to one month after the treatment.

We will be applying Demand CS (Cyhalothrin-lambda 0.03%, PCP #27428) to the exterior, and we may use a variety of baits inside; Advance Granular (Abamectin B1 0.011%, PCP #27864), Attack Ant Killer (Borax 5.4%, PCP #20203), Drax Gold (Orthoboric Acid 5%, PCP #20478).

Avoid touching treated areas.
